

## **Guide for Clubs and Competition Secretaries July 2006 – Edition 8**

Sample Schedule based on the 8<sup>th</sup> Edition of the ADAA Regulations due for effect on the 1<sup>st</sup> July 2006 detailing a variety of ways in which clubs may wish to offer events to enable dogs to be entered. This is a guide to help clubs formulate schedules for the new regulations and may be subject to change with the final version of the Regulations yet to be ratified. This is by no means a schedule that is recommended, but rather demonstrating how to put together a schedule by offering events to enable Juniors and Regular registered dogs to be offered events.

Additionally, it demonstrates the use of Open A and Open B categories. Within a single competition, the club may deem all Open events to be Open B or all to be Open A, or have some of each.

All of the bar heights for each class are listed besides the event so that it is easy for you to see the changes. At any time dogs may be entered in height classes above their own, but never below. A dog may only compete once on each course though. I.e. A Midi dog may be entered in Combined-Starters Maxi Agility Test and on the same day be entered in Intermediate Midi Agility Test. The new bar height of 150mm must be altered on equipment by July 2007 (NSW equipment trailer already altered). In the mean time, 2 crossed bars must be used to lower the bar jump height for Regular, Combined and Junior Toy classes and this must be noted on the schedule.

All events listed on a schedule must be offered to dogs from the International register. The club may choose which events will be offered the extra classes that allow either or both Regular registered dogs and Junior competitors.

The best way to work out what you want; is to work out a basic schedule (which standards and how many course changes that you want) and then add in the extra classes as desired for both Regular and Junior. Combined Starters, Elementary and Team/Pairs games allow both Regular and International registered dogs, so Regular classes are never required for these events. Open events are never offered to Junior competitors as separate classes. Advanced events are never offered to either Junior competitors Regular registered dogs as separate classes.

**Classes Ring One - Start TBA – Judge TBA**

*(Sample Starters event not including Juniors, but included both Regular and International registered dogs.)*

- 1a. Combined Starters Maxi Agility Test (jumping 550mm)
- 1b. Combined Starters Midi Agility Test (jumping 400mm)
- 1c. Combined Starters Mini Agility Test (jumping 250mm)
- 1d. Combined Starters Toy Agility Test (jumping 150mm)

*(Sample Elementary event including Junior competitors and all other competitors.)*

- 2a. Combined-Elementary Toy Agility Test (jumping 150mm)
- 2b. Junior-Elementary Toy Agility Test (jumping 150mm)
- 2c. Combined-Elementary Mini Agility Test (jumping 250mm)
- 2d. Junior-Elementary Mini Agility Test (jumping 250mm)
- 2e. Combined-Elementary Midi Agility Test (jumping 400mm)
- 2f. Junior-Elementary Toy Agility Test (jumping 400mm)
- 2g. Combined-Elementary Maxi Agility Test (jumping 550mm)
- 2h. Junior-Elementary Maxi Agility Test (jumping 550mm)

*(Intermediate course including International and Regular Register dogs and Junior competitors)*

- 3a. Intermediate Maxi Agility Test (jumping 650mm).
- 3b. Intermediate Midi Agility Test (jumping 550mm).
- 3c. Intermediate Mini Agility Test (jumping 400mm).
- 3d. Intermediate Toy Agility Test (jumping 250mm).
- 3e. Regular-Intermediate Toy Agility Test (jumping 150mm).
- 3f. Regular-Intermediate Mini Agility Test (jumping 250mm).
- 3g. Regular-Intermediate Midi Agility Test (jumping 400mm).
- 3h. Regular-Intermediate Maxi Agility Test (jumping 550mm).
- 3i. Junior-Intermediate Maxi Agility Test (jumping 550mm).
- 3j. Junior-Intermediate Midi Agility Test (jumping 400mm).
- 3k. Junior-Intermediate Mini Agility Test (jumping 250mm).
- 3l. Junior-Intermediate Toy Agility Test (jumping 150mm).

*(Open course including both International and Regular registered dogs. Open B symbolises that dogs must have their AAD title to enter these events)*

- 4a. Open B Maxi Agility Test (jumping 650mm).
- 4b. Open B Midi Agility Test (jumping 550mm).
- 4c. Open B Mini Agility Test (jumping 400mm).
- 4d. Open B Toy Agility Test (jumping 250mm).
- 4e. Regular-Open Maxi Agility Test (jumping 550mm).
- 4f. Regular-Open Midi Agility Test (jumping 400mm).
- 4g. Regular-Open Mini Agility Test (jumping 250mm).
- 4h. Regular-Open Toy Agility Test (jumping 150mm).

*(Individual Game for International Registered dogs only. Games must now be offered at for all 4 height categories. Open A symbolises that dogs without their AAD title may compete in these events)*

- 5a. Open A Maxi Individual Snooker (jumping 650mm)
- 5b. Open A Midi Individual Snooker (jumping 550mm)
- 5c. Open A Mini Individual Snooker (jumping 400mm)
- 5d. Open A Toy Individual Snooker (jumping 250mm)

**Classes Ring Two - Start TBA – Judge TBA**

*(Individual game for both International and Regular register dogs. Open B symbolises that dogs without their AAD title may not compete in these events)*

- 6a. Open B Maxi Individual Gamblers (jumping 650mm)
- 6a. Open B Midi Individual Gamblers (jumping 550mm)
- 6a. Open B Mini Individual Gamblers (jumping 400mm)
- 6a. Open B Toy Individual Gamblers (jumping 250mm)
- 6a. Regular-Open Maxi Individual Gamblers (jumping 550mm)
- 6a. Regular-Open Midi Individual Gamblers (jumping 400mm)
- 6a. Regular-Open Mini Individual Gamblers (jumping 250mm)
- 6a. Regular-Open Toy Individual Gamblers (jumping 150mm)

*(Only dogs with at least their SAAD title and are International registered may compete in this event.).*

- 7a. Advanced Maxi Jumping Test.
- 7b. Advanced Midi Jumping Test.
- 7c. Advanced Mini Jumping Test.
- 7d. Advanced Toy Jumping Test.

*(Open course including both International and Regular registered dogs. Open A symbolises that dogs without their AAD title may enter these events)*

- 8a. Open A Toy Jumping Test (jumping 250mm).
- 8b. Open A Mini Jumping Test (jumping 400mm).
- 8c. Open A Midi Jumping Test (jumping 550mm).
- 8d. Open A Maxi Jumping Test (jumping 650mm).
- 8e. Regular-Open Maxi Jumping Test (jumping 550mm).
- 8f. Regular-Open Midi Jumping Test (jumping 400mm).
- 8g. Regular-Open Mini Jumping Test (jumping 250mm).
- 8h. Regular-Open Toy Jumping Test (jumping 150mm).

*(Intermediate course including International Register dogs and Junior competitors)*

- 9a. Intermediate Maxi Jumping Test (jumping 650mm).
- 9b. Intermediate Midi Jumping Test (jumping 550mm).
- 9c. Intermediate Mini Jumping Test (jumping 400mm).
- 9d. Intermediate Toy Jumping Test (jumping 250mm).
- 9e. Junior-Intermediate Toy Jumping Test (jumping 150mm).
- 9f. Junior-Intermediate Mini Jumping Test (jumping 250mm).
- 9g. Junior-Intermediate Midi Jumping Test (jumping 400mm).
- 9h. Junior-Intermediate Maxi Jumping Test (jumping 550mm).

*(Team and Pairs games are offered as part of the Combined programme and dogs registered on both the International and Regular registers are eligible to enter. They are only offered in these two height categories with the bars heights as described here. Open A symbolises that dogs without their AAD title may enter these events.)*

- 10a. Combined-Open A Maxi Team Game (jumping 550mm)
- 10b. Combined-Open A Mini Team Game (jumping 250mm)

**Note:** Dogs may only be entered in any one Class a, b, c, d, e, f, g, h, I, j, k or l from each event.
